PETITION FOR PRE-BIRTH DETERMINATION OF  
PARENTAGE INVOLVING A DONOR

19-A M.R.S. §§ 1921-1929

**NOW COME(S)** the petitioner(s) who request this court to determine parentage and parental rights and responsibilities of the subject minor child(ren) under the Maine Parentage Act, 19-A M.R.S. §§ 1921-1929. In support of is request, the petitioner(s) state(s) as follows:

5.  Petitioner(s) agree to be the exclusive parent(s) of any resulting child(ren) and agree to accept all parental rights and responsibilities of any resulting child(ren) immediately upon the birth of the child(ren).
6.  Maine has jurisdiction in this case because all parties to the petition agree to submit to the jurisdiction of this State, and at least one of the parties resides in this State.

**WHEREFORE**, pursuant to 19-A M.R.S. § 1934, petitioner(s) request an order:

- Designating the contents of the birth certificate(s) in accordance with 22 M.R.S. § 2671 and directing the Office of Data, Research and Vital Statistics to designate the intended parent(s) as the parent(s) of the child(ren);
- Declaring that the intended parent(s) are the parent(s) of the resulting child(ren), and ordering that all parental rights and responsibilities vest exclusively in the intended parent(s) immediately upon the birth of the child(ren);
- Sealing the record from the public to protect the privacy of the child(ren) and the parties; and
- For any further relief that the court determines necessary and proper.
