JUVENILE CONDITIONS OF RELEASE

15 M.R.S. § 3203-A(5)

The Court finds probable cause to believe the juvenile named above has committed a juvenile crime and the juvenile is released, pending further court proceedings on the condition that the juvenile:

Based on the attached reasonable efforts findings, reasonable efforts have been made to prevent or eliminate the need for removal of the juvenile from the juvenile's home or no reasonable efforts are necessary because of the existence of an aggravating factor and continuation in the juvenile's home would be contrary to the welfare of the juvenile.

- Abide by curfew:
