**AGREEMENT OF JUVENILE AND
ORDER DEFERRING DISPOSITION**

15 M.R.S. § 3311-B

Pursuant to 15 M.R.S. § 3311-B, I am the above-named juvenile, I have entered an admission, and I agree to:

- 1. A period of deferment.
- 2. Go to court on the date and time I am notified to appear.
- 3. Not do anything that would constitute a juvenile crime, crime, or civil offense.
- 4. Identify myself as being on deferred disposition if arrested or questioned by law enforcement and to notify the District Attorney's Office in writing of any contact with law enforcement within 96 hours after that contact.
- 5. Notify the court named above in writing of any change in my address or telephone number within 24 hours after the change by filing the Notice of Change of Address form (CR-CV-FM-199).
- 6. Comply with all items listed on the Conditions of Release Order issued on (mm/dd/yyyy)

- 7. Other:

I understand that if I violate any of the above requirements, I may be arrested and detained, I can be required to meet different or additional requirements of deferred disposition, and I can be terminated from deferred disposition and have a disposition imposed immediately.

By signing here, I acknowledge that I understand the provisions of this order, I have received a copy of this order, I agree to comply with the above requirements, and I agree to have my disposition deferred to a later date.
