## MOTION TO REOPEN INSTRUCTIONS

A Motion to Reopen is a request made by a defendant who has had a judgment entered against them on a traffic citation (ticket) and would like a judge to reopen the matter for further review. This request is made using the Motion to Reopen (form number MJBVB-18). There is a required \$25 filing fee (per violation) to file the Motion to Reopen. If you are unable to pay the filing fee you may request that a judge waive it using the Application to Proceed Without Payment of Fees (form CV-67) and supporting Affidavit (form CV-191). These forms may be found on the Maine Judicial Branch website (www.courts.maine.gov) or may be picked up in person at any clerk's office. Visit the court website for locations of all state courts.

When filing a motion to reopen, be aware of the following:

- Either you or your attorney (if you have one) must sign the motion.
- The \$25 filing fee (per violation) is non-refundable and cannot be applied to fines.
- If the violation(s) you would like to reopen relate to a failure to produce evidence of insurance/registration/license and/or permit, you may submit valid proof when filing the Motion to Reopen.
- Any outstanding fines remain due and any license/registration suspensions ordered in this case remain in effect unless otherwise ordered.

When the Violations Bureau has received your Motion to Reopen it will be given to a judge to review. If it is granted, the case will be set for trial **OR** it may be dismissed. If it is denied, the judgment stands and the fine previously assessed remains due. A copy of the judge's decision will be sent to you at the address provided on your motion.
