Electronic court records are available <u>only</u> in courts and for cases where eFiling has been implemented. PLEASE NOTE: You must register for an account on the <u>Odyssey Portal</u> before submitting this form. If you do not register before submission the request will be denied.

It may take 3-5 days to activate your account. Once activated, you will receive an email that the account is ready to use. To learn more, visit www.courts.maine.gov/ecourts.

This form can be submitted by mail <u>or</u> in person at any court clerk's office. If you submit the form by mail, the "For Notary Use" section on page 2 must be completed by a notary public. If you submit the form in person, you must present a valid form of ID (driver's license, state issued ID, US passport, etc.). If the notary section on page 2 is completed, ID is not necessary when submitting the form in person.
