CASE SEARCH IDENTIFIERS FOR MAINE ECOURTS

The case identifier, or case number, used to access the electronic case files through eFileMaine, re:SearchMaine, and the Odyssey Portal is composed of:

- 1. A two- or five-letter alphabetic prefix This represents the venue (court location) and jurisdiction
- 2. A two- or three-letter alphabetical code This represents the type of action/case type
- 3. A four-digit numerical series This represents the year the action was initiated
- 4. A five-digit number This represents the case number in order of filing in the court where pending

The variation between alphabetical codes is dependent on when the action was initiated, and specifically whether it was before or after the "Go-Live" date listed below.

1. ALPHABETIC PREFIX - VENUE AND JURISDICTION

The alphabetic prefix representing the court will differ for Superior Court Civil/Real Estate matters depending on the date the action was initiated and where. See the table below.

The alphabetical prefix for all District Court matters remains the same as those assigned prior to the "Go-Live" date.

2. ALPHABETICAL CODE - TYPE OF ACTION/CASE TYPE

The alphabetical prefix is followed by an alphabetic code that represents the case type. This is either two- or three-letters, depending on the date the case was initiated. Cases initiated prior to the "Go-Live" date listed below have five-letter code, while cases initiated after the "Go-Live" date have a seven-letter code.

Case type codes assigned prior to "Go-Live" are generic codes, while case type codes assigned after "Go-Live" are more specific to the type of action.

3. 4-DIGIT NUMERICAL SERIES - YEAR OF CASE INITIATION

The two- or three-digit case type code is followed by the 4-digit number representing the year the case was initiated in the court it is pending. All four digits of the year must be entered.

4. 5-DIGIT NUMBER - CASE NUMBER IN ORDER OF FILING

This represents the case number in order of filing in the court where it is pending.

The system does not require the entry of preceding zeros in case numbers of four (4) or fewer digits. For example, case number LEWDC-SMC-2022-00001 will be retrieved if entered in this format: lewdcsmc20221.
