JURISDICTIONAL AFFIDAVIT

4 M.R.S. § 152(5-A)

Pursuant to 4 M.R.S. § 152(5-A), in order for the District Court to accept a for filing a petition for guardianship, adoption, or name change concerning a minor child, there must already be a **pending** case in the District Court concerning custody or other parental rights concerning that child, OR a case involving the child must have already been **transferred** from a Probate Court.

A “pending” case is a case that has been filed in a District Court, is being litigated in that court, and/or is awaiting decision by that court. In order to assist the District Court in determining whether it has jurisdiction, you must provide the following information:
